- Successful completion of an academic Bachelor's degree with at least two courses in statistics.
- To strengthen their application applicants may decide to take and provide results of GRE/GMAT
- As courses are taught in English, proven proficiency in English is required for non-native English speakers.



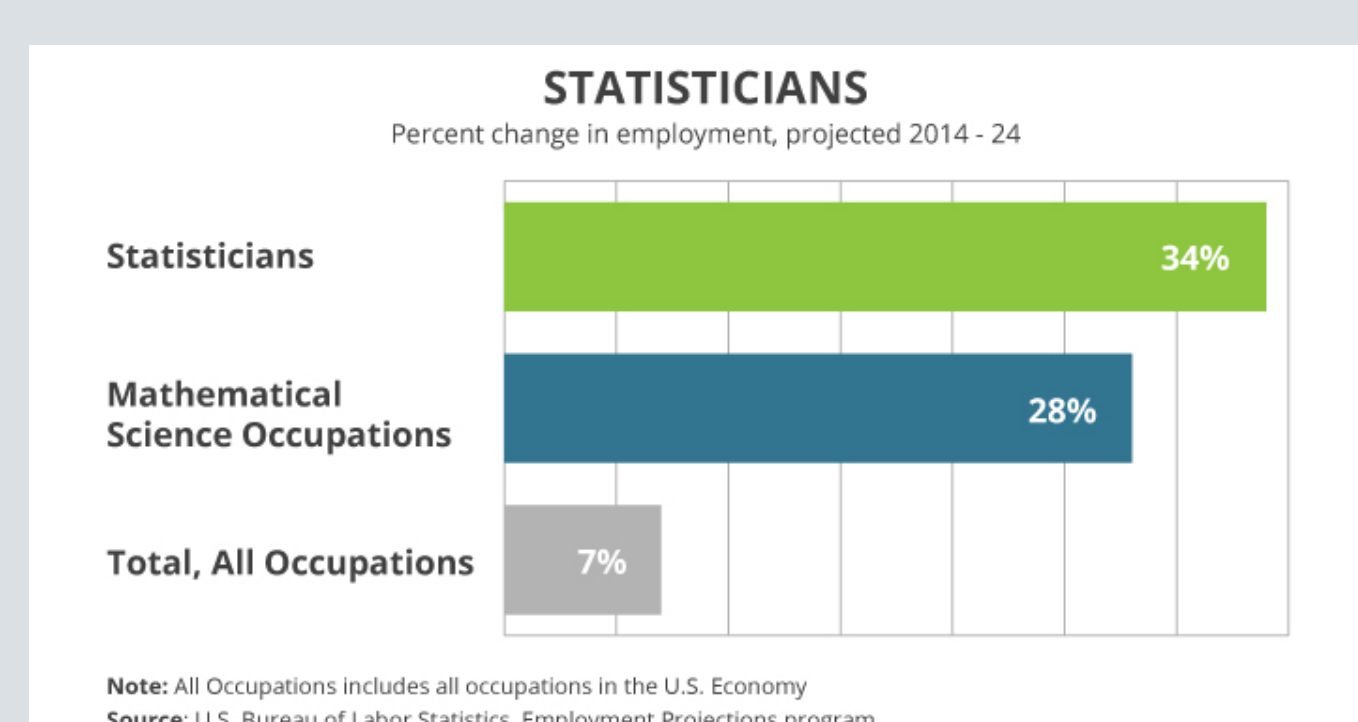
### Accreditation
