Goal & Policy relevance

Goal: Provide forest-stress data

The project is in line with EUs guideline on sustaining the quality of life, more precisely

- the **protection of our natural world**, where forests play a vital role in regulating our climate, storing carbon and providing sustainable materials
- Climate adaption and preparedness: maintaining healthy forests will help to mitigate impacts driven by climate change such as flash-floods, landslides
- Providing data for early warning systems







Methodology

- 1. Temporal resolution: 2017-2024 for Apr. Sep.
- 2. Spatial resolution: 100 m
- 3. Datasets
 - o Sentinel-2 Time Series (monthly mean composites)
 - NDVI, EVI, LWC, LCI
 - o ERA5 Temperature Data (monthly mean)
 - o **NUTS3** regions
 - o Corine LC: forest mask
- 4. Calculate **delta** between months of current year (2024) to months from the baseline (2017-2023)

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Novelty of this approach

- 1. Map environmental-induced stress of forests
 - o does not solely rely on droughts
 - o Includes parameters that display the status of forests
- 2. Monitor forest health on a fine scale in near-real time
